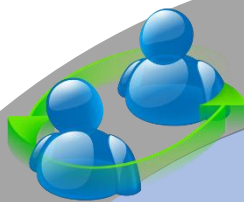



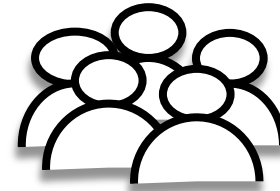

LRA: Bridging actor



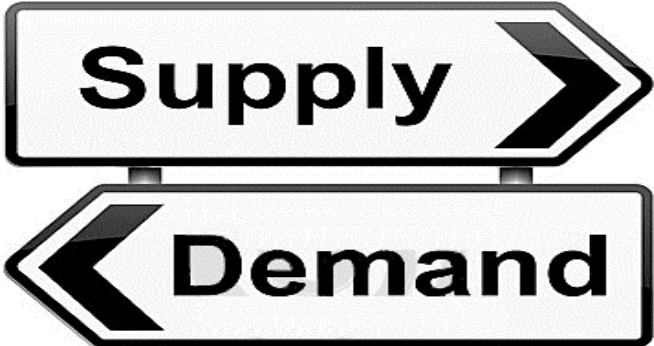
Multistakeholders



Local & Regional Authorities' role on C.E.

Behaviour change (citizens, enterprises)
Awareness campaigns, Regulations, Local taxes as Pay-As-You-Throw System (PAYT), etc.

Public procurement (public authorities)

Focus on :

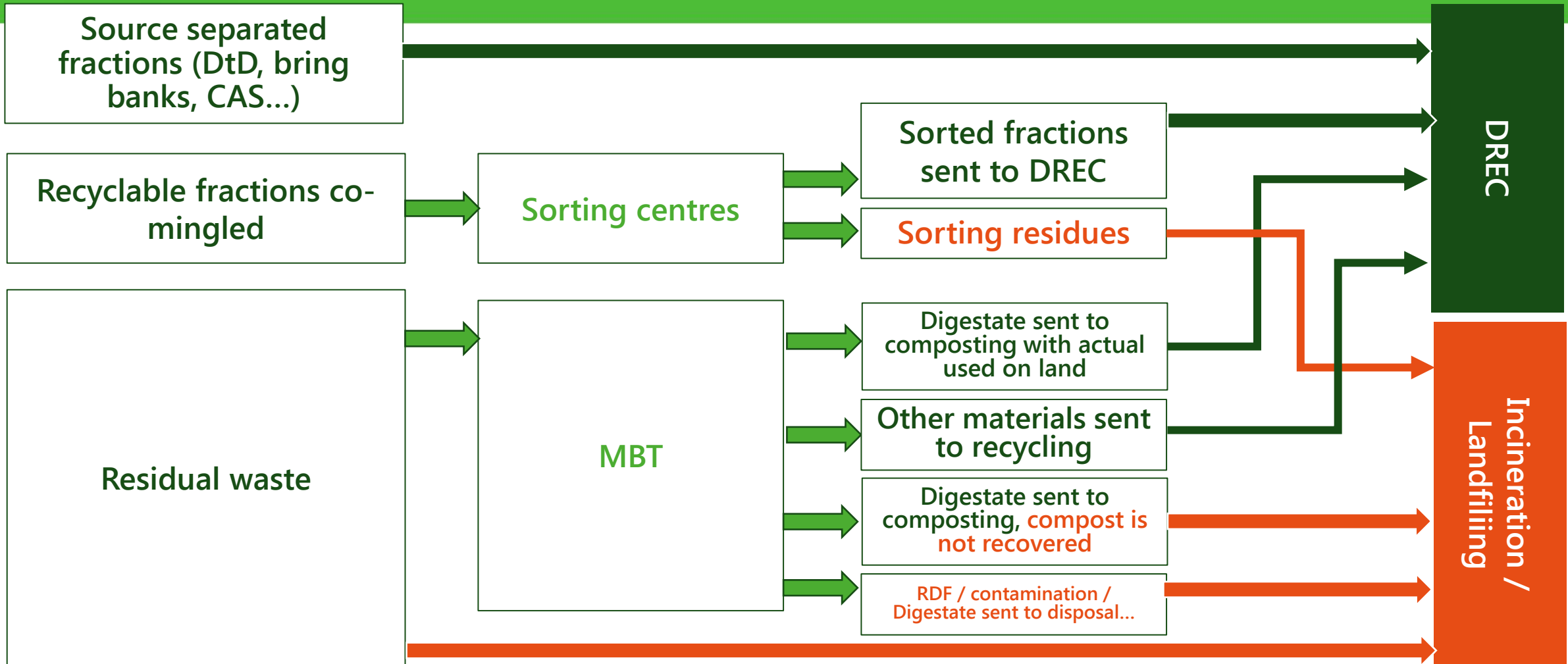
The common scope of the DREC methodology:
